

## San Diego Surf Cup XXV

July 25, 2005 Release

The following table describes the *field of competition* for **San Diego Surf Cup XXV** in 2005. The information provided includes a breakdown of the field by 2004/2005 State Cup and National Cup results, and by geography. In youth soccer, the state of California has been split into two states, Northern California and Southern California. "Out of State" in this context means outside of Southern California. Also, an age group may have more than one State Champion from the same state due to combining age groups (e.g. two Washington State Champions in the U-19 means one team won the U-17 and the other won the U-18 State Cup tournament for 2004/2005 season).

In youth soccer, age groups are defined as "Under" an upper age limit. U-19 therefore means all players are under the age of 19 as of August 1<sup>st</sup>. College coaches will be scouting the U-19, U-17, and U-16 age groups in this tournament. Over 350 college coaches came to scout in 2004.

In the older age groups (U-16 to U-19), there are 156 teams. Of those, 120 (77%) made their State Cup final four. The **Girls U-17 Super Group is the most competitive in the tournament**, with 11 of 16 teams State Cup Champions and 4 more State Cup Finalists or Semi-Finalists. The **Boys U-17 Super Group** is extremely competitive with 6 State Cup Champions and 6 State Cup Finalists or Semi-Finalists. In the younger weekend, the Girls U-14 has 7 State Cup Champions, while the Boys U-13 has 6 State Cup Champions. We have 10 USYSA Regional Champions in the tournament and 6 USYSA Regional Finalists.
